Jubilee Year of Hope

This weekend, we formally open the Jubilee Year here in Natchez with a solemn celebration at St. Mary Basilica at the 10AM Sunday Mass. During the year, Catholics are able to receive a plenary indulgence (under the usual conditions) for walking through the holy doors at any of the four major basilicas in Rome or by visiting the Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth.

Also, the same indulgence is available for those who make pilgrimage to the Diocesan Cathedral or any church designated by the Bishop as a pilgrimage site. St. Mary Basilica has been designated one of these pilgrimage sites during the Holy Year.

You are also able to receive the indulgence for performing acts of charity such as serving the poor or visiting the imprisoned.

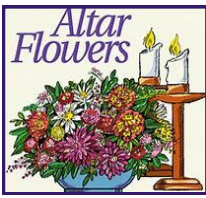

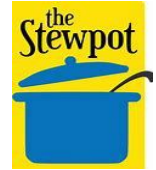


WINNER OF YOUTH RAFFLE FUNDRAISER
