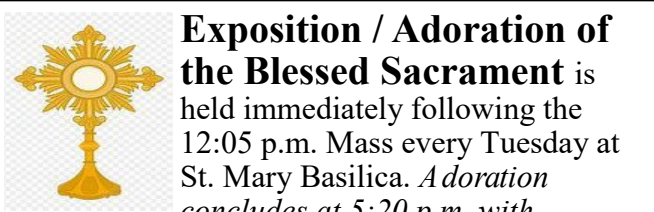

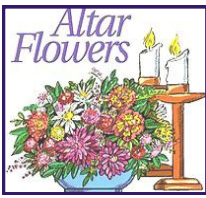

This organization serves families with children newborn to age 5, older disabled children, and adults with monthly diaper assistance. Currently the only requirements to apply are proof of state-issued id and a copy of the birth certificate with proof of Mother or Father signature. All eligible applicants will receive a two-week supply of diapers, pull-ups, baby wipes or formula. Eligible Senior Citizens receive two weeks supply of incontinence products to include: briefs and/or pads, bed pads, adult cleansing wipes. They also serve adolescent and adult women who are in need of personal hygiene/period products.

CATHEDRAL TO BASILICA

A basilica is a church building that has been recognized and accorded special privileges by the Pope. The name Basilica is derived from a Greek term meaning "Royal House."

Designation as a Basilica indicates a special bond of communication with the Pope. A parish must celebrate "with particular care" each year the feast of the Chair of Peter on February 22, the Solemnity of the Apostles Peter and Paul on June 29, and the anniversary of the Pope's election or his inauguration.

Basilicas have on display -

- ◇ The Conopaeum or Ombrellino— Silk Canopy in the traditional papal colors of yellow and red
- ◇ The Tintinnabulum— Bell mounted on a pole
- ◇ Crossed Keys— Papal symbol displayed on the Basilica.

There are 1,850 Minor Basilicas in the world, and the Basilica of St. Mary here in Natchez is one of 93 in the United States.

JANUARY 22, 2024 DAY OF PRAYER for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court legalized abortion throughout the United States in its companion decisions *Roe v. Wade* and *Doe v. Bolton*. Since that time, millions of children have lost their lives, and millions of women and families have been wounded by abortion.

On June 24, 2022, the *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* decision overturned *Roe v. Wade*, and we praise God for the great opportunity state and federal legislators now have to protect pre-born children. While God, in His mercy, ended the nearly fifty-year nationwide regime of abortion on demand, right now state and federal laws, in many instances, are still hostile to pre-born children. So, great prayer and advocacy is very needed.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM), no. 373, designates January 22 as a particular day of prayer and penance, called the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children":

In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.
