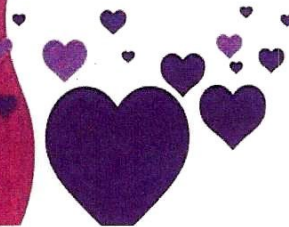

Parents who plan to have their child / baby baptized at St. Mary Basilica or at Assumption Catholic Church

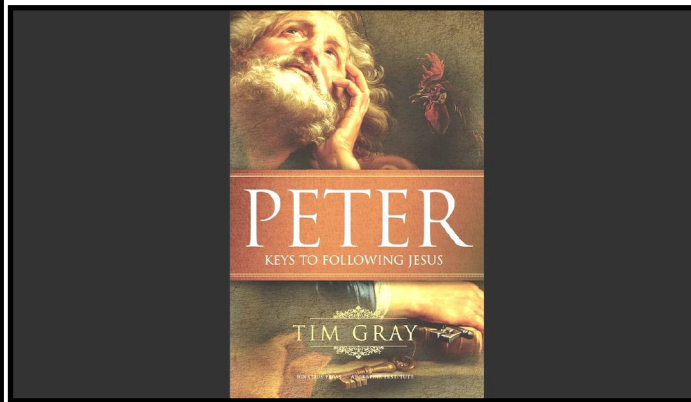

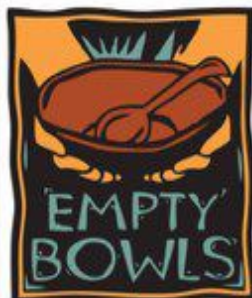

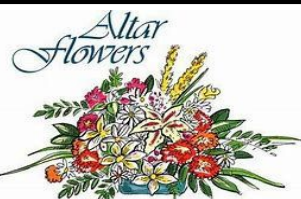
