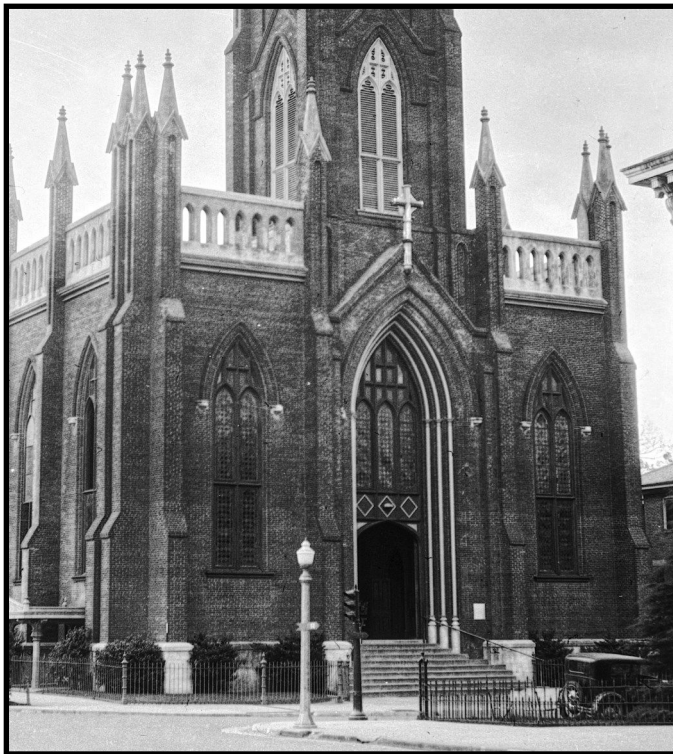


SYMPATHY

The Missing Cross

An item in *The Daily Democrat* dated October 25, 1883, reported a cross was erected above the entrance arch of St. Mary Cathedral. The item reads as follows: "A handsome, large cross has been erected on the arch over the doorway of St. Mary's Cathedral."

However, over time, the cross fell and broke into pieces, leaving a void where it once stood. The exact date of the cross's fall is unknown.

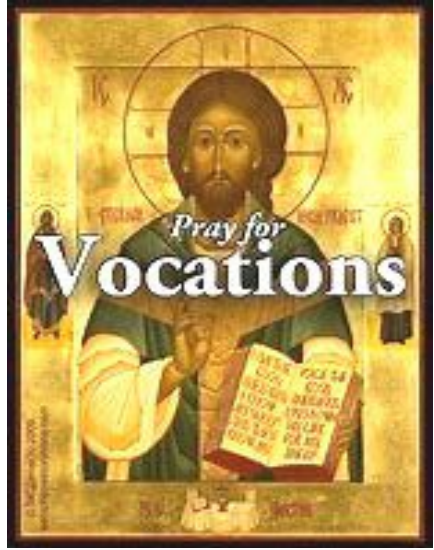
