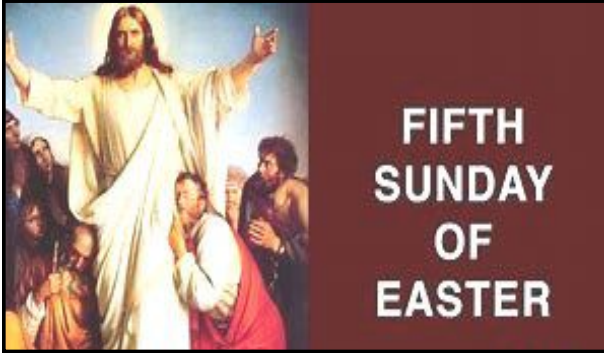

DAILY PRAYER FOR PRIESTS

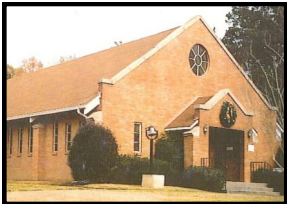
