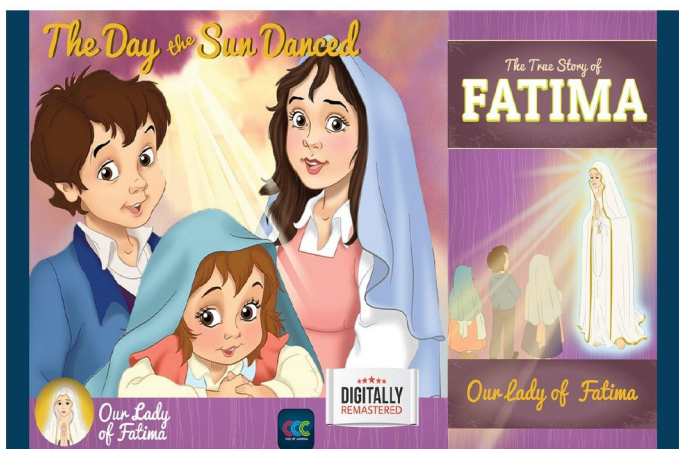

COMING SOON - Mary's House Catholic Bookshop



Located in the historic St. Therese Hall below the Basilica Church, Mary's House will provide devotional items and gifts to visitors and locals alike, along with books and articles specific to the Basilica parish and its history. The entrance to the new bookshop will be located on the Main Street side of STH. A section of the shop will be dedicated specifically to goods made by the monks of St. Joseph Monastery in Natchez, with the proceeds of these sales going to support the lives of the monks.

The shop will provide an entry way into the future Catholic Cultural Center (located in the former STH Parish Library), which will feature exhibits on the history of Catholicism in Natchez and Mississippi.

A \$10,000 raffle is being held to cover the start-up cost of the shop. Only 200 tickets will be sold. Winner receives \$10,000. Tickets may be purchased from Cathedral High School students or from the church office in the Family Life Center.

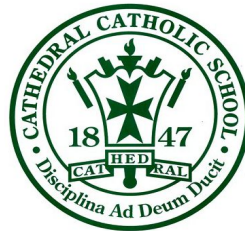
