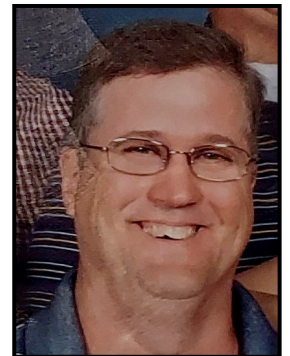

LIVING GOSPEL

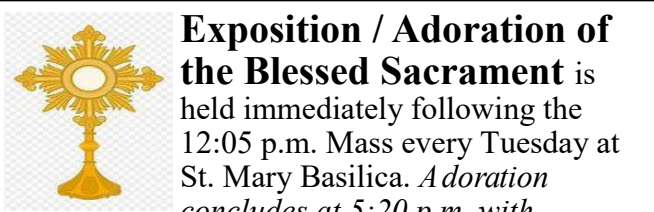

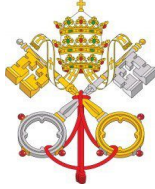

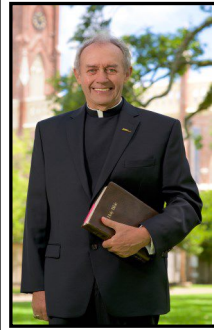
SECOND COLLECTION June 29/30 PETER'S PENCE

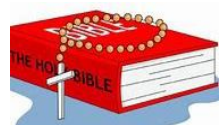
ASSUMPTION SUNDAY INVITATION TO ROSARY AND COFFEE/DONUTS

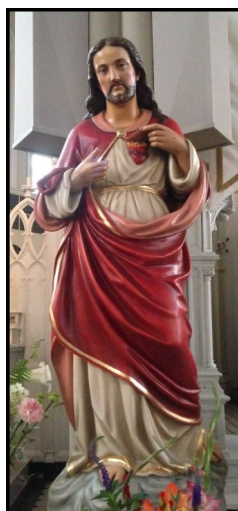

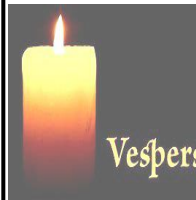
