



# REMINDER —PROTECTION OF CHILDREN

The Catholic Church has always demonstrated a concern for children. The Diocese of Jackson is committed to ensuring that children served by the church are not at risk of sexual abuse by the Church personnel. Diocesan policies and procedures currently in place seek to protect, enhance and, in some cases, restore the trust that our faith calls for between agents of the Church and the children and adolescents entrusted to our care.

In accordance with the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People passed by the U.S. bishops in Dallas, the Diocese of Jackson wishes to encourage any victim of sexual abuse by a member of the Catholic Clergy to come forward and begin the healing process. When an allegation is found to be credible, counseling will be offered, so that the healing process can begin in accord with our present diocesan policy. We encourage any victim to contact Ms. Erika Rojas, Victim Assistance Coordinator at 601-326-3736.

#### Catholic Charities Announcement

Catholic Charities is an important ministry of the Diocese of Jackson serving numerous people on the margins of our communities through it various programs. After five years as Executive Director, Mrs. Wanda Thomas has decided it is time for new leadership and has submitted her resignation. We are grateful for her years of service and ask God's blessing for her and her family.

The search for a new Executive Director will commence soon. Meanwhile, at the recommendation of the Board of Directors, I have appointed Msgr. Elvin Sunds as Interim Executive director. #### FATIMA ROSARY October 26, 2024








