

# **Traveling for PhD Studies**

From November 20 through December 1, I will be in Vienna, Austria, to attend a research seminar related to my PhD studies in Liturgical Theology. During this time, I will meet with other members of the PhD program at the University of Vienna so we can peer-review each other's work and have time for more extensive research. During that time, there are some changes to the liturgical schedule at St. Mary. I apologize for the way my absence will affect the daily Mass and Confession schedule, but I hope we can take this as an opportunity to pray for more priests to our area.

There will be no daily Masses during my absence. There will be an 8AM School Mass on Wednesday, November 20. Adoration will continue on Tuesday as scheduled. Fr. Tristan Stovall will take my place for the weekend of Christ the King Sunday. This will be Fr. Tristan's first opportunity to celebrate Mass at St. Mary and Assumption since his ordination. I hope everyone will congratulate him and assure him of our prayers. There will be Mass on Thanksgiving day at 9 AM at St. Mary. The following weekend is the First Sunday of Advent, and Sunday Masses will take place as usual at both churches. Masses will resume as normal on December 2.




Cathedral Catholic School youth are now selling raffle tickets as part of their fundraising for the 2025 March for Life

# ST. MARY BASILICA OUTREACH TO FAMILIES IN NEED CHRISTMAS 2024

St. Mary Basilica Parish, in preparation for Christmas 2024, will once again provide Christmas assistance for 30 families. The families have been selected by St. Mary Basilica Community Services Commission. The children in these families range in age from infants through 12 years old. A profile of the families and their wish lists is published in this weekend's parish bulletin.

If you do not feel that you are in a position to adopt a family, there are once again specially labeled envelopes available for a donation toward the food cards that are purchased to accompany each family's gifts. The food cards are restricted to the purchase of food items only. These envelopes are located in the pews. You may drop your donation in the collection basket or drop it by the church office.

• Beginning this weekend, November 16/17, following the weekend Masses, members of the Community Services Commission will be in the back of the Basilica by the cry room to assist you in selecting a family to adopt (you will receive family name and address at that time). Two or more families might join together to adopt a family. You are not bound by the items on the wish list. We are asking the adopting families to contact the adopted families directly and make arrangements for pickup or delivery of gifts by Wednesday, December 13, 2024. This plan will allow the parents to pick up or receive the gifts without the children's knowledge. This might be the only "Santa Claus" the children will have. Prior to the exchange of gifts, please pick up the Natchez Market gift card from the church office to include in your gifts. Please contact Betty Lou Hicks at 601 807-6104 if you have questions or run into any problems.

If you are not able to adopt a family after Mass, we encourage you to call the church office or Betty Lou Hicks (601-807-6104) to select a family to adopt. The information regarding the selected family will be mailed to you.
